

## **Aberdeen Forward Landfill Tax Credit Scheme General Guidelines**

The project/amenity must be open to the public, and not operated with a view to profit

The project/amenity must be located within the city of Aberdeen

An upper funding limit of £30,000 has been set for each application

Aberdeen Forward will look for match funding of at least 25% to be in place

### **Priorities**

- Projects that innovatively seek to expand the use of existing facilities to address a community need e.g. a drop-in cafe, or a museum education room for use by the community
- Projects that improve the quality of, or create parks, play areas, green spaces, indoor and outdoor sports facilities, amenity green space and provision of facilities for teenagers and children in order to improve quality of life

Examples of project types supported by Aberdeen Forward

- Parks and Gardens
- Green corridors
- Amenity greenspace
- Community gardens and city (urban) farms
- Natural and semi-natural green spaces
- Outdoor sports facilities
- Provision for children and teenagers
